

US-EPA Grant Funds Available for Brownfield Site Assessments

**The Genesee County Land Bank has
EPA funds available to support brownfield redevelopment**

Program Facts:

- The EPA funds can be used to support brownfield projects by funding or partially funding the following environmental sites assessment activities on qualified sites:
 - Phase I Environmental Assessments
 - Phase II Environmental Assessments
 - Baseline Environmental Assessments
 - Brownfield Plans

Eligibility Facts:

- You may be eligible for these assessments if the GCLBA approves your application
- Projects must support economic development, neighborhood revitalization and/or create jobs
- Eligible applicants include private, public, and non-profit organizations which are not responsible for or have not contributed to the contamination on the property at the time of application
- Match funds required

Application Process:

- Complete a project application and return to the GCLBA with supporting documents
