The following information is to be incorporated into the bidding and contract documents and acknowledged by all bidders for the above referenced project. Bids submitted that do not acknowledge this Addendum will be deemed incomplete and may be rejected on such basis.

1. Questions and Answers:

Q: Is there a typo on page 30, which is part of the bid form? The form states "LB-20-006-2 Seventh MLK".

A: Yes. This is a typo. The UNIT PRICE FOR ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION WORK should list "BID LIST # - LB-20-007". An updated UNIT PRICE FOR ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION WORK is attached (ATTACHMENT 1).

Q: I am trying to find a contractor who is licensed with the City of Flint who performs concrete sidewalk work. Do you have a contact I can use to get a list of licensed contractors in Flint (as specific to concrete contractors as possible)? Also, do you have information regarding the specifications for the sidewalks (mix specs, width, depth of concrete, etc.)?

A: GCLBA does not have a listing of contractors that are licensed with the City of Flint to perform concrete sidewalk work, nor do we have information regarding the City's specification for the work. Many of our bidders apply to be sidewalk certified contractors directly with the City of Flint Clerk's office, who issues the license.

Reach out to the City of Flint's Clerk Office for information regarding meeting their specs. The Building Inspection office should also have some good information as they may not approve final inspections if sidewalks have been damaged/decimated.

Regarding the sidewalks on 20-007: the removal of sidewalks is for those on site only. Sidewalks in the Right of Way and not a site improvement specific to the structures to be demolished are to be protected. If the contractor damages sidewalks beyond their current state of repair, then the contractor will be responsible for replacing the damaged sidewalkto include having the work completed by a City of Flint Certified Sidewalk Contractor.
