Pre-Qualification Process

Read entire packet and pay attention to details.

Confirm you meet minimum qualifications, including:

- Proof of financial stability
- Certificate of good standing from the State of MI
- 5 years of documented equivalent experience on regulated demos
- Bonding capacity
- Appropriate Licenses
- Capacity
- Disclosure of debarments, suspensions and violations

Pre-Qualification Process

Complete and submit pre-qual application

GCLBA completes detailed review

Application approved or denied with detailed explanation

Contractor may re-submit if denied.

Bidding Process

Meet additional requirements- funding or project specific i.e: Capacity, Insurance, Disclosures, Sam.gov

Use Reference Checklists

Additional Requirements: Door Hangers, Yard Signs, Soil Erosion Permits/Waivers, Well Abandonment, sidewalk repair/licensing and permits

MIOSHA – Worker Safety

- Licensing / Certifications / Health Monitoring
- Alternate Work Plans
- 1% Fee
- Notifications Required
- Activities on site

EGLE - Environmental safety/Air Quality/Hazardous Waste/ Tires

- Notification Required
- Revising/Cancelling notifications
- Off site and Notifications
- Regulates transport and disposal

Federal/State Regulations

ALL LAND BANK DEMOS ARE REGULATED -THRESHOLDS DON'T APPLY

MIOSHA/EGLE

- Drywall and joint compound
- Asbestos less than 1%
- Wetting/Waivers
- Air monitoring requirements: lead, asbestos, cadmium, personals, perimeter, clearance

- Promote Subcontracting Opportunities!
 - Abatement
 - Trucking
 - Landscaping
 - Excavating
 - Pumping/disposal
 - Debris removal
 - Well abandonment
 - Sidewalk (only licensed through the City of Flint for sidewalk repair! CoF Clerk for licensing/DPW for permit)
- Verify your subs for insurance & licenses. Land Bank verification also required.




